POLAND

Monitoring and Reporting on the Status of OFWs in Poland SUBJECT:

Per report of POLO-Geneva of rampant contract substitution in Poland resulting in the running away of OFWs from their respective employers, and pursuant to Rule I, Part VIII of the Revised POEA Rules and Regulations Governing the Recruitment and Employment of Land-based Overseas Filipino Workers of 2016, as reiterated in Memorandum Circular No. 12, Series of 2018, all Philippine Recruitment Agencies deploying Overseas Filipino Workers (OFWs) to Poland are directed to monitor and address alleged violations of the terms and conditions of employment of OFWs in Poland, and immediately report the same to the Director, Welfare and Employment Office, Attention: Welfare Services Branch (WSB)

Non-compliance shall be dealt with accordingly.
