Resumption of Flights in Côte d'Ivoire (Ivory Coast)

The Government of Côte d'Ivoire (Ivory Coast) closed land, aviation and maritime borders on 22 March 2020. Land and maritime borders remain closed through August 31 2020. Cargo shipments are not affected.

On 26 July 2020, the DFA reported that Côte d'Ivoire in West Africa has authorized air travel and the operations of all its domestic and international flights have resumed.

All arriving and departing passengers must adhere to strict medical protocols and other preventive measures against COVID-19. Travelers departing from, arriving in, and transiting through Côte d'Ivoire are required, in addition to following all health measures related to COVID-19, to fill in an Air Travel Declaration Form (Déclaration de Déplacement par Voie Aérienne – DDVA) which should be completed online at: https://deplacement-aerien.gouv.ci/#/.
