## Precautionary Measures in the State of Israel

Due to the recent clashes and upsurge of violence in Jerusalem and in the Gaza Strip, all Filipinos in Israel are reminded to take all the necessary precautionary measures, as follows:

- 1. Be alert and stay within the employer's residence;
- 2. Avoid going to places near the Gaza border, the West Bank (Bethlehem, Jericho, Hebron, etc.) and stay away from the following places in Jerusalem:
  - Temple Mount
  - Damascus Gate
  - Herod's Gate
  - Al Wad Road
  - Musrara Road
  - Sheik Jarrah, Silwan, At-Tur (Mount of Olives, Ras-Al-Mud and Issawiyah) in East Jerusalem
- 3. Avoid crowded places especially near protest areas;
- 4. Do not take pictures of the ongoing violence;
- 5. Go to the nearest bomb shelter or protected area when sirens are rung;
- 6. Follow instructions of the Israel security forces and Israel Home Front Command;
- 7. In case of emergency, call the following hotline numbers:
  - a. Philippine Embassy +972-54-466-1188
  - b. Police 100
  - c. Magen David Adom (Ambulance/Emergency Medical Service) 101
  - d. Fire 102
  - e. Israel Electric Corporation 103
  - f. Home Front Command 104
  - g. Municipality Call Center 106/107/108

The Philippine Embassy in Tel Aviv has already called on a security meeting to discuss the plans of action in case the violence escalates.
