

: ALL LICENSED PHILIPPINE RECRUITMENT AGENCIES (PRAs) DEPLOYING

CAREGIVERS TO ISRAEL

SUBJECT: SUBMISSION OF MONITORING REPORTS ON THE STATUS AND CONDITION

OF THE DEPLOYED CAREGIVERS

In view of the possible escalation of the ongoing conflict between the Israelites and the Palestinians towards a full-scale war and pursuant to POEA Memorandum Circular (M.C.) No. 9, Series (S). of 2019, you are hereby reminded to submit reports in the OFW Welfare Monitoring System (OWMS) on the status and condition on all your deployed caregivers to Israel, particularly, on those newly deployed.

You are likewise directed to submit a full written report containing full details of all coordination efforts with the Foreign Recruitment Agency to the Welfare and Employment Office, addressed as follows.

Monitoring and reporting the status and condition of deployed Filipino workers onsite is in compliance with Section 209, Rule I, Part VIII of the Revised POEA Rules and Regulations Governing the Recruitment and Employment of Landbased Overseas Filipino Workers of 2016 and M.C. No. 12, S. of 2018.

Please be guided that significant and critical incidents involving a deployed Filipino worker should be reported to the POEA within five (5) days from occurrence, thereof. Hence, both reports in the OWMS and in writing must be submitted not later than 21 May 2021.

Failure to submit the required reports shall warrant the imposition by the Administration of such sanctions as it may deem appropriate.
