

GOVERNING BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 10
Series of 2006



WHEREAS, there are more than four hundred (400) licensed agencies servicing the overseas requirement for Filipino household workers;

WHEREAS, the POEA database consistently shows that newly issued licenses using manpower request for household workers (HHWs) as their new market merely account for less than 10% of total newly-hired HHW deployment;

WHEREAS, despite the low deployment performance, those aspiring to secure a license continue to use the recruitment of household workers to comply with the new market requirement because of the relative facility to secure new job orders from foreign placement agencies;

WHEREAS, the continued proliferation of licensed agencies servicing this market will lead to cut-throat competition among the stakeholders to the detriment of our workers;

WHEREAS, there is a need to restrict the issuance of a new license using the recruitment of Household Workers as its new market;

NOW, THEREFORE, the POEA Governing Board, in a meeting duly convened, **RESOLVES AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** to suspend the issuance of new licenses to applicants using the recruitment of Household Workers as their new market.

POEA is instructed to strictly comply with this resolution in the issuance of new licenses.
