GOVERNING BOARD RESOLUTION No. Series of 2017

WHEREAS, His Excellency, President Rodrigo Roa Duterte instructed all concerned government agencies to accelerate and streamline the issuance of government permits and clearances for the convenience of the public;

WHEREAS, the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) through the President Directive No. 2016-0337 was tasked to study the provision of an identification card for Overseas Filipino Workers (OFWs) that can also be used for OFW related transactions:

WHEREAS, pursuant to President's directive, the DOLE prepared a concept paper for the development and implementation of OFW ID Card System as a major component of the Integrated DOLE System or iDOLE System that was presented to the Cabinet during its February 7, 2017 meeting and was approved by the President during the same meeting:

WHEREAS, to facilitate the implementation of the OFW ID Card System, the DOLE with the participation of the POEA, initiated a consultation with other government agencies such as the Development Bank of the Philippines (DBP) and its Data Center, Inc. (DCI), the APO Production Unit, Inc., Overseas Workers Welfare Administration (OWWA), the Philippine Postal Corporation (PHILPost), and the Bureau of Immigration (BI), for the forging of a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) that will delineate their individual roles and responsibilities in the production, printing, and distribution of IDs and in the processing of payment to be received, including corresponding reports;

NOW, THEREFORE, the POEA Governing Board, in a meeting duly convened, RESOLVES AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to grant authority to the POEA to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the DOLE, the Development Bank of the Philippines (DBP) and its Data Center, Inc. (DCI), the APO Production Unit, Inc., the Philippine Postal Corporation (PHILPost), Overseas Workers Welfare Administration (OWWA), and the Bureau of Immigration (BI) that will put into fruition the conceptualized OFW identification card as part of the iDOLE System.
