Governing board resolution no. 09

Series of 2021

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 10022 authorizes the POEA Governing Board, after consultation with the Department of Foreign Affairs (DFA), to impose a ban on the deployment of Filipino migrant workers in pursuit of national interest or when public welfare so requires;

WHEREAS, the POEA issued Governing Board Resolution No. 2, Series of 2020, imposing a total deployment ban on the processing and deployment of all OFWs following the raising of the alert status to Alert Level 4 by the Department of Foreign Affairs (DFA);

WHEREAS, the DFA in its letter to the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) dated 11 October 2021, lowered the Crisis Alert Level in Iraq from Alert Level 4 (Mandatory Repatriation Phase) to Alert Level 3 (Voluntary Repatriation Phase) upon the recommendation of the Philippine Embassy in Baghdad, Iraq;

WHEREAS, POEA has previously issued Governing Board Resolution No. 6, Series of 2018 granting exemptions on the documentation of returning workers, except household service workers under the selective Balik–Manggagawa Exemption Program as proposed by the DFA even with the imposition of Alert Level 3;

NOW, THEREFORE, the POEA Governing Board in a meeting duly convened, RESOLVES AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to impose a deployment ban on the processing and deployment of newly hired workers and to exempt the documentation of returning workers, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The OFW is an active worker in Iraq with proof of recent stay in Iraq (e.g. proof of departure from Iraq or proof of billing);
- 2. Proof that the OFW is returning to the same employer/company (e.g. Employment Contract);
- 3. Contract between OFW and employer conforms with Philippine and Iraqi labor laws;
- 4. The OFW work site is outside the following No-Go-Zones, namely:

- a. The Provinces of Anbar, Nineveh, Kirkuk and Mosul
- b. Sadr City, Baghdad Province
- c. Amedi, Erbil Province
- d. Mahkmour, Erbil Province;
- 5. The employer of the OFW signs an undertaking guaranteeing secured work premises in Iraq;
- 6. The employer of the OFW signs an undertaking guaranteeing financial sponsorship and facilitation of the repatriation of the OFW from Iraq covering both airfare and visa penalties, if any; and
- 7. The OFW is not a household service worker (HSW).
