EDSA ANNIVERSARY JOBS FAIR AT POEA GROUNDS

The Philippine Overseas Employment Administration announced today that it will hold a jobs fair on February 25 at its office in Ortigas, Mandaluyong City for the 24th EDSA Anniversary celebration.

The jobs fair which will be attended by 26 landbased agencies and 5 seabased agencies seeks to fill in vacancies for hotel workers, construction work, and nurses. Recruitment will also be conducted for seabased workers such as captains, utilities, messman, oilers, and machinists. More than 5,000 job orders will be made available to overseas job applicants.

POEA Administrator Jennifer Jardin-Manalili said that among the countries that will be in need of foreign workers are Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, United Arab Emirates, Qatar, Kuwait, Bahrain, Taiwan and Brunei Darussalam.

The jobs fair will start at 8 am and end at 5pm. Interested applicants are advised to bring the following documents: self-made bio-data/resume with detailed job description, valid passport, high school/college diploma, transcript of records, valid PRC ID, board certificate/board rating, valid NBI Clearance, employment certificate, trainings skills certificate, OMA certificate (for Muslim applicants), and 1 piece 2x2 colored picture.
