6th EPS-KLT RESULTS OUT

The Philippine Overseas Employment Administration congratulates the successful examinees of the Korean Language Test (KLT) conducted last May 2, 2010. Of the 6,466 examinees who took the test, 2,755 representing 42.7 per cent passed.

Maria Elena De Asis from Baesa, Quezon City got a perfect score of 200 points, followed by Bernard Landicho of Sariaya, Quezon, who scored 196 points. Nitze Camansi of Danao City, Cebu, and Cecile Matias of Nueva Ecija both got 192 points.

The Philippines was given a total of 7,100 slots as the number of applicants to be included in the 2010 Roster of Jobseekers. The number is considerably greater than the successful examinees, thus, prompting another test to be likely conducted by the Human Resource Development Service of Korea in cooperation with the POEA this year.

The examinees of the recently concluded KLT may now view the results of their examinations in the POEA website www.poea.gov.ph. The successful examinees who scored 80 points and above are reminded to immediately submit to the POEA their fit-to-work medical certification from any DOH-accredited clinic for their names to be included in the List of Jobseekers for EPS-Korea. ###
