Triple Win Project offers opportunity for more Filipino nurses to work in Germany

The International Placement Service of the German Federal Employment Agency (ZAV/BA) has opened 550 positions for qualified Filipino nurses under the Triple Win Project.

The positions are as follows:

Intensive Care, Anesthesia	-	250 positions
Operating Room, Surgery Section	-	100 positions
Neurology, Orthopedics or related fields	-	100 positions
Geriatric Care	-	100 positions

To qualify, applicants must be Filipino citizen, male or female and permanent resident of the Philippines with:

- Bachelor of Science in Nursing (four years professional education)
- Active Philippine Nursing License
- At least two years of professional experience as nurse in hospitals, rehabilitation centers and care institutions
- German language proficiency
 - Willing to undergo German language training in the Philippines to attain Level B1 (to be paid by the employer)
 - or
 - B1 or B2 language proficiency level in accordance with the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages

Selected applicants shall receive a starting gross monthly salary of €1,900. After recognition as a qualified nurse, the monthly salary is raised to € 2,300.

The employer will pay the visa and airfare from the Philippines to Germany and will assist the successful candidate find a suitable accommodation. The employee will bear the expenses in full or in part of the board and lodging.

The first group of Filipino nurses left for Frankfurt on 14 December 2013.
