## 11 more Filipino in Germany now qualified nurses under the Triple Win Project

A total of sixty-six Filipinos are now working in Germany under the Triple Win Project as Qualified Nurses (Gesundheits-und Krankenpflegerin) after 11 more nurses passed the Recognition Examination.

The 11 Filipino nurses who passed the Recognition Examination are: Aliling, Homer; Anonuevo, Jane; Diaz, April; Gutiza, Lizette; Fenequito, Krischelle; Salomon, Elizabeth; Solis, Virtue; Canoy, Reza; Zaparilla, Jo-Ann; Maniaol, Joey; and Musa, Georgina.

As of September 2016, 170 Filipino nurses were already deployed under the Triple Win Project. Some 300 nurses are either undergoing language training or awaiting training schedule.

The Triple Win Project started in March 2013 after Germany's Federal Employment Agency (BA) and the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) signed a bilateral agreement.

Under the agreement, the BA's International Placement Services (ZAV) recruits hospital employers willing to support Filipino candidates, while the German Agency for International Cooperation (GIZ) prepares the nurses to be deployed and provides integration services and monitoring of candidates onsite

The POEA, on the other hand, recruits and deploys qualified nurses whose immediate goal is to fulfil their requirements for recognition and German language proficiency level.
