POEA advises OFWs in Israel to stay alert, safe

The Philippine Overseas Employment Administration (POEA) advises Filipino workers in Israel to stay alert and safe amid the clashes and upsurge of violence in Jerusalem and Gaza Strip.

OFWs are advised to stay within the employer's residence and avoid going to places near the Gaza border, the West Bank (Bethlehem, Jericho, Hebron) and places in Jerusalem, particularly in Temple Mount, Damascus gate, Herod's Gate, Al Wad Road, and Musrara Road, Sheik Jarrah, Silwan, At-Tur in East Jerusalem.

The POEA also advised OFWs to avoid crowded places, especially near the protest areas and do not take photos of the ongoing violence.

Also, OFWs are asked to go to the nearest bomb shelter or protected area in their location when the sirens are rung, and follow the instructions of the Israel security forces and Israel Home Front Command.
